MATH 0045 (Intermediate Algebra) for NC residents

- This course is designed for students who need to take MATH 1065 or 1064 but have not met the minimum SAT/ACT/High School GPA requirements.
- If you are transferring a college level math (such as college algebra, pre-calculus, calculus) your
 do not need remedial math. If you are bringing in AP Credit for Calculus, you do not need
 remedial math.
- MATH 1050 is not the same course as remedial. The two courses are not related in any way.
- This course is for NC residents ONLY.

MATH 0001 (Intermediate Algebra) for OUT OF STATE residents

- This course is designed for students who need to take MATH 1065 or 1064 but have not met the minimum SAT/ACT/High School GPA requirements.
- If you are transferring a college level math (such as college algebra, pre-calculus, calculus) your
 do not need remedial math. If you are bringing in AP Credit for Calculus, you do not need
 remedial math.
- MATH 1050 is not the same course as remedial. The two courses are not related in any way.
- This course is for OUT OF STATE students ONLY.





MATH 1050 Explorations in Mathematics

- No minimum SAT/ACT score needed.
- All "non science" majors such as Anthropology, Criminal Justice, English, Foreign Languages (non education concentrations), Geography, History, Philosophy, Political Science, Religious Studies, and Sociology take this math
- Can take MATH 1050 in Fall or Spring or summer school
- MATH 1065 is required by pre-professional/health related graduate programs (Medicine, Dental, OT, PT, PA, Pharmacy, Optometry, Veterinary) so if you are pursuing one of these programs, you should NOT take MATH 1050. Consult academic advisor for further advice.
- If you are transferring in this math or a higher level math (such as college algebra, precalculus, calculus) your do not need MATH 1050. If you are bringing in AP Credit for Calculus, you do not need MATH 1050.

MATH 2228 Elementary Statistical Methods I

- No minimum SAT/ACT score needed.
- The same majors listed above will also accept this math
- Can take MATH 2228 in Fall or Spring or summer school





- MATH 1064 Applied Mathematics for Business
 - Requires placement via SAT/ACT score or unweighted HS GPA
 - Economics (& Business majors) should take this math.
 - Can take MATH 1064 (section 003 or 006 only) in Fall or you may wait until Spring





- MATH 1065 College Algebra (Restricted until August 1st for Priority Majors)
 - Requires placement via SAT/ACT score or unweighted HS GPA
 - Applied Atmospheric Science, Biology, Biochemistry, Chemistry, Foreign Language (education) Geology, GIST, Math, and Physics take this math.
 - MATH 1065 is also required by pre-professional/health related graduate programs (Medicine, Dental, OT, PT, PA, Pharmacy, Optometry, Veterinary)
 - Those majors (Applied Atmospheric Science, Biology, Biochemistry, Chemistry, Geology,
 Math, and Physics are listed as "Priority Majors" and should be able to register for Math 1065
 NOW (as long as there is availability).
 - ALL OTHER majors (Foreign Language-education, and GIST) must WAIT until the "priority major restriction" is lifted on August 1^{st.} If there are openings in MATH 1065 on August 1st, you can take it in the fall or you may wait until the spring.
 - You can discuss your graduate school goal with your advisor in the fall.
 - If you are transferring in college algebra or a higher level math (such as pre-calculus, calculus) your do not need MATH 1065. If you are bringing in AP Credit for Calculus, you do not need MATH 1065. Students in these situations may take the next level math required by their major. Consult academic advisor with questions.



Do you Need Remedial Math?

- You will <u>only</u> need Remedial Math if your major requires MATH 1065 (College Algebra) or MATH 1064 (Applied Math for Business) and you do not meet one of the following criteria
 - Math SAT score of 570
 - Math ACT score 23
 - Final High school <u>unweighted</u> GPA of 2.96
