Your Responsibility as Advisee

- Monitor your ECU email *daily*
- Schedule Regular Advising Meetings
 - Meet with advisor once per semester to discuss progress/receive new pin
 - Registration pin changes each semester
- Maintain Clear and Honest Communication
 - Read notes/emails provided by your advisor
 - Communicate openly, honestly and respectfully about any challenges you face
 - Be receptive to feedback from advisor
- Take Responsibility for your Educational Journey
 - Accept consequences for decisions, actions, and academic progress
 - Come prepared to advising appointments
 - Understand your graduation requirements

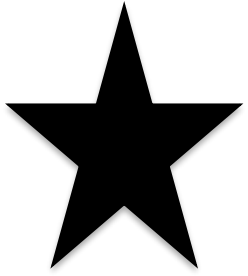

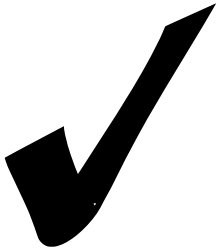

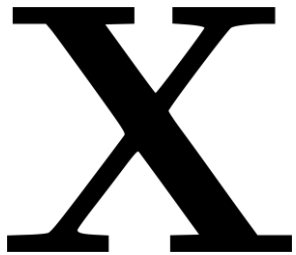
